Poitín



Poitín or poteen is a traditional Irish distilled, highly alcoholic beverage (60%-90% ABV).

Poitín was traditionally distilled in a small pot still and the term is a diminutive of the Irish word *pota*, meaning "pot".

It is traditionally distilled from malted barley, grain, potatoes or whey.

Irish moonshine, along with all other private distillation not specifically licensed by the state, was outlawed in 1661.

On 7 March 1997, the Irish Revenue Commissioners withdrew their opposition to Poitín being sold under license in the Republic of Ireland.
